Day 1:- Arrive Delhi. Transfer to Hotel, Sightseeing in Delhi.

(Dinner)

Welcome to New Delhi, the Capital City of India, combined with the best features of a modern city such as a metro system, bustling markets and fabulous eating places. The past and the present meld seamlessly together, making centuries-old monuments a part of the city's daily life. Delhi is very much a history's child.

- Delhi showcases an ancient culture and a rapidly modernising country. Dotted with monuments there
 is much to discover here. The seat of many powerful empires in the past, its long history can be traced
 in its many carefully-preserved monuments, ancient forts and tombs.
- On arrival, transfer to hotel and Check in.
- Start your trip with visiting the cremation site of Mahatama Gandhi- Raj Ghat, it was here where Mahatma Gandhi's last rites were performed on January 31, 1948, a day after his death, and its neighbouring memorials.
- Later proceed to the Famous Jama Masjid, Red fort in the walled city. You can also go for some street shopping for which Delhi is known for.
- In the evening, back to Hotel.
- Dinner and Overnight in Delhi.

Day 2:- Delhi City Tour.

(Breakfast & Dinner)

- Today after breakfast, get ready for a fun filled City tour of Old and Historic Delhi.
- Start with Delhi's top attraction the Qutub Minar: A sense of awe will overcome visitors when their eyes glimpse the tall minarets of Qutub Minar. Then proceed to Humayyun's tomb: is special because its architecture would eventually become the inspiration for the Taj Mahal's design, one of the Seven Wonders of the World.



- Later witness at the centre of New Delhi stands the 42 m high India Gate, an "Arc-de-Triomphe" like archway in the middle of a crossroad. Almost similar to its French counterpart, it commemorates the 70,000 Indian soldiers who lost their lives fighting for the British Army during the World War I.
- Proceed to Akshardham Temple, and you will also be able to have a glimpse of the government buildings, such as the Presidents House, Paliament House.
- In the evening, back to Hotel.
- Dinner and Overnight in Delhi.

Day 3:- Depart Delhi / Arrive Agra. Taj Mahal and Agra Fort. Evening free for shopping. (Breakfast & Dinner)

- Today after breakfast, checkout from hotel and proceed to the majestic city of Agra.
- Arrive Agra and start the sightseeing with the Monument which symbolizes Love. The UNESCO World heritage Site: the marvellous TAJ MAHAL.
- It still holds a position in the List of the Seven Wonders of the World.
- An immense mausoleum of white marble, built in Agra between 1631 and 1648 by order of the Mughal emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his favourite wife, the Taj Mahal is the jewel of Muslim art in India and one of the universally admired masterpieces of the world's heritage.

Later proceed to the Agra fort. Near the gardens of Taj Mahal stands the important 16th-century Mughal monument known as the Red Fort of Agra. This powerful fortress of red sandstone encompasses within its 2.5-km-long enclosure walls, the imperial city of the Mughal rulers. The forbidding exteriors of this fort hide an inner paradise. There are a number of exquisite buildings like Moti Masjid - a white marble mosque akin to a perfect pearl; Diwan-E-Am, Diwan-E-Khaas, Agra Fort, an excellent example of Mughal architecture, is one of the few UNESCO World Heritage Sites in India.



- Evening free time for shopping handicrafts and souvenirs from the Agra Market.
- Back to Hotel.
- Dinner and Overnight in Agra.

Day 4:- Depart Agra / Arrive Jaipur. Enroute Visit Fatehpur sikri.

(Breakfast & Dinner)

- Today after Breakfast, checkout from the hotel, and proceed to Fatepur Sikri.
- Behold the way the turrets and the domes of Fatehpur Sikri, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, hem a sunset sky doused in all kinds of crimson by plunging themselves in abject darkness.
- Later Proceed to Jaipur: Welcome to the Pink city of India: Jaipur. This famous travel place best reflects the opulent Rajputana architecture, traditions and history of the state. However, this is not all that make Jaipur a popular tourist attraction; the fact that the city is a flavour some fusion of old and modern keeps it all interesting for travellers.
- On arrival, transfer to hotel and check in.
- Dinner and Overnight in Jaipur.

Day 5:- Jaipur City Tour.
