Day 1:- Arrive Jabalpur / Transfer to Bandhavgarh National Park.

(Dinner)

- Arrive at Jabalpur Airport. Board our vehicle & proceed for Bandhavgarh National Park.
- On Arrival, transfer to tree house in Bandhavgarh National Park & check in. Rest of day is free for leisure.
- Dinner and Overnight in Bandhavgarh National Park.

Day 2:- Bandhavgarh National Park.

(Packed Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- Enjoy your morning excursion at Bandhavgarh National Park. Packed breakfast will be provided today.
- Bandhavgarh is a place of mythological and legendary significance. The ancient Bandhavgarh Fort is of great importance as it is believed to have been gifted by Lord Rama to his younger brother Lakshmana. 'Bandhav' in English means brother and 'Garh' means fort. Hence the name, Bandhavgarh. Bandhavgarh dates back to 2000 years ago and you will find several man-made caves with inscriptions and rock paintings.



- Bandhavgarh is also the land of tigers. This is the place to visit if you want to spot the big cat. India's top dwelling for tigers, Bandhavgarh National Park has the highest density of Royal Bengal tigers in the world. The sight of the majestic tiger, up close and personal, is said to trigger a sense of awe in you, of the kinds you would have only experienced in your childhood.
- Lunch and Dinner at hotel. Overnight in Bandhavgarh National Park.

Day 3:- Depart Bandhavgarh / Arrive Kanha National Park. (550 kms | 5 hrs)

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- Have an early breakfast, checkout & proceed for Kanha National park.
- Mid way, visit "Ghughua Fossil National Park". Ghughua Fossil Park is a National Park, located near Shahpura in Madhya Pradesh, India, in which plant fossils belonging to 31 genera of 18 families have been identified. Numerous plant, leaf, fruit, seed, and shell fossils can be found in this park, some of which dates as far back as 65 million years, the most prominent of which are the palm fossils.
- Lunch and Dinner at Hotel. Overnight in Kanha National Park.

Day 4:- Kanha National Park.

(Packed Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- Enjoy your morning & afternoon excursion at Kanha National Park.
- Get ready for the excursion. Kanha National Park is the largest national park of Madhya Pradesh & a feast for the eyes for wildlife enthusiasts.
- Lunch at the Hotel.
- An epitome of conservation, successful rehabilitation of the Hard ground Swamp Deer (Barasingha) speaks about the dedication & efforts of the forest dept as well as the local population.
- It is also the first tiger reserve in India to officially introduce a mascot, "Bhoorsingh the Barasingha".

- Dinner and Overnight in Kanha National Park.

**Day 5:- Depart Kanha National Park / Arrive Satpura National Park. (350 kms | 8 hrs).
(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)**

- Have an early breakfast, check out from the hotel and Proceed to Satpura National Park
- Arrive Satpura National Park and Check in at the Hotel. Rest of the evening is free for leisure.
- Lunch and Dinner at the Hotel.



- Overnight in Satpura National Park.

**Day 6:- Satpura National Park.
(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)**

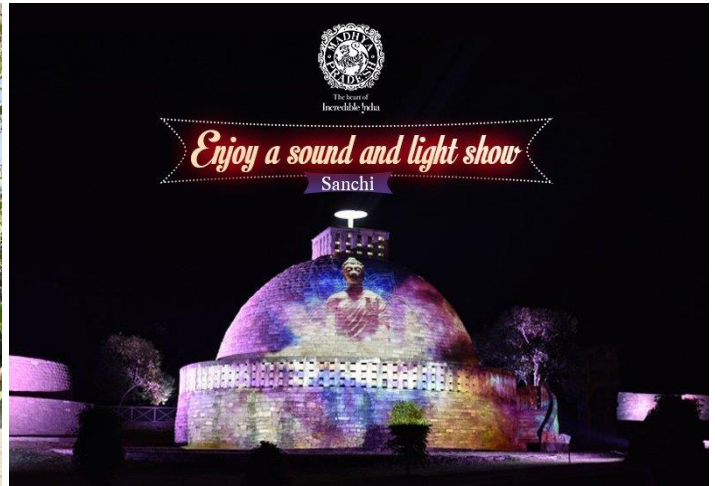
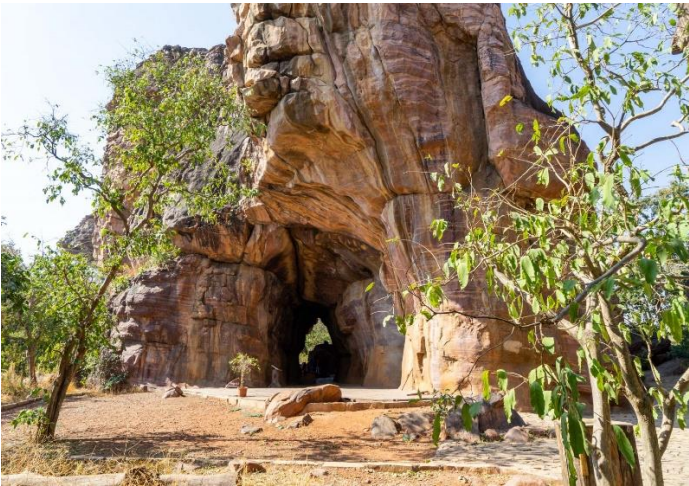
- After early morning breakfast, you will be met by our associate who will assist you to reach the boat jetty, board the speed boat & cross the Denwa River. After the necessary forest formalities, board our customized 4x4 vehicle to explore the flora & fauna of Satpura National Park
- Avail the morning safari in the core area.
- Madhai is located at the entrance of the most exquisite and beautiful forests in India - Satpura. Few places in the world can compete with its raw wilderness, absolute tranquillity and the air of mystique. It delights you with its rich wildlife, sprawling meadows, unending backwaters and spell-binding views that leave you awestruck and get you to be completely in sync with the magic of nature.
- Lunch at the Hotel.
- Later, in the evening, at around 5 pm, board our customized vehicle & proceed for a night safari which lasts till 9 pm.
- Dinner and Overnight in Satpura National Park.

**Day 7:- Satpura National Park.
(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)**

- After breakfast, early morning, you will take to the jetty for an exclusive canoe ride on the Denwa River.
- Each canoe can accommodate 2 guests & 1 naturalist who would be describing the flora & fauna of the park. During this time of the year, the river is a primary habitat of migratory birds & a canoe ride is a wonderful way to be close to them. You will also be taken deep inside the forest & you can witness wildlife too.
- Lunch and Dinner at the hotel.
- Overnight in Satpura National Park.

**Day 8:- Depart Satpura National Park. Visit Bhimbetka Rock Shelters. Arrive Sanchi.
(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)**

- Early morning you will be joined by the forest rangers who will take you for an out of the world “Forest Walk” experience in the dense woods of Satpura National Park.
- At the rest point, you can have breakfast & witness crocodile’s lazying around in the winter sun.
- After breakfast, checkout from the hotel & proceed for “Bhimbetka Rock Shelters”, a UNESCO World Heritage site.
- An archaeological treasure, Bhimbetka has around 243 rock shelters. The paintings found in the rock shelters here have a striking resemblance to the ones discovered in Kakadu National Park in Australia; to the cave paintings of Bushmen in Kalahari Desert and Upper Paleolithic Lascaux cave paintings in France. Cave paintings dating back to approximately 30,000 years. Rock shelters that were home to humans, millennia ago. And a rich flora and fauna surrounding these, indeed, make Bhimbetka a gift to us from our earliest ancestors.



- Lunch at Highway treat, Bhimbetka, after Lunch Proceed for Sanchi.
- On arrival, transfer to hotel and check in.
- Proceed for sightseeing in Sanchi.
- The town of Sanchi is synonymous with Buddhist Stupas - hemispherical structures typically containing relics of the Buddha or his followers. The Stupas of Sanchi were constructed on the orders of Emperor Ashoka to preserve and spread the Buddhist philosophy. Sanchi has been protecting these beautiful and sacred architectural wonders, just the way these wonders have been safeguarding ancient history and art of the Mauryan period.
- Visit numerous stupas, temples, monasteries and an Ashokan pillar have been the focus of interest and awe for global audiences as well. In fact, UNESCO has given the status of 'World Heritage Site' to the Mahastupa.
- Later at 07:00pm enjoy Sound and Light show at the Sanchi Stupa.
- Back to hotel.
- Dinner and Overnight in Sanchi.

Day 9:- Depart Sanchi. Udaygiri Caves, Bhojpur & Bhopal Sightseeing. Arrive Home. (Breakfast)

- After Breakfast Check out from your hotel and Proceed to Udayagiri Caves.
- The Udayagiri Caves are twenty rock-cut caves near Vidisha, Madhya Pradesh from the early years of the 5th century CE. They contain some of the oldest surviving Hindu temples and iconography in India. One of India's most important archaeological sites, the Udayagiri hills and its caves are protected monuments managed by the Archaeological Survey of India.
- Later proceed to Bhojpur. Bhojpur is situated on the Betwā River, 28 km from Bhopal & takes its name from king Bhoja (reg. c. 1000–1055 CE), the most celebrated ruler of the Paramāra dynasty. Bhojpur is famous for the incomplete Bhojesvar temple dedicated to Shiva. The temple houses one of the largest liṅga-s in India, 5.5 m (18 ft) tall and 2.3 m (7.5 ft) in circumference. It is crafted out of a single rock. The building is under the protection of the Archaeological Survey of India.

- Later, proceed for Bhopal. Visit the various sightseeing of Bhopal.
- Split by a pair of lakes, Bhopal is two cities within a city. Two starkly contrasting cityscapes. Towards the North you have the old city, a fascinating area of mosques, serpentine alleys, chowks, milling crowds, exotic havelis and crowded bazaars. South of the two lakes is the new Bhopal. Modern, with wide roads, upmarket shopping complexes, and plush hotels and restaurants nestled comfortably in the Arera and Shamla Hills, which overlook the lakes and the old city beyond. The central district is known as New Market. Both Bhopal's enamor you in their own way and vie to bring out the child within you.
- Later Proceed to Bhopal airport for your flight home with wonderful memories & souvenirs from your Madhya Pradesh Holidays.
