Day 1:- Arrive London. Evening Thames River Cruise.

(Dinner)

- Welcome to London. Upon arrival at the airport, you will be transferred to your hotel in London.
- Arrive at the Hotel and Check-in.
- In the evening, we will proceed for Thames River Cruise.
- Relax in a modern river cruise vessel with panoramic windows and see some of the London's famous riverside attractions, such as the Tower of London, Tower Bridge, and the Globe Theatre.
- After cruise, proceed for Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Dinner back to hotel.
- Overnight in London.

Day 2:- Visit to Windsor Castle. City Tour of London with Guide.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- Today after breakfast, proceed to Windsor.



- Windsor is a town on the River Thames in southeast England, just west of London. It's home to Windsor Castle, a residence of the British Royal Family. Built by William The Conqueror in the 11th century, the castle was extensively remodeled by subsequent monarchs. Public tours take in the State Apartments, which contain opulent furnishings, and paintings from the royal art collection.
- The original castle was built in the 11th century after the Norman invasion of England by William the Conqueror. Since the time of Henry, I, it has been used by the reigning monarch and is the longest-occupied palace in Europe. The castle's lavish early 19th-century State Apartments were described by the art historian Hugh Roberts as "a superb and unrivalled sequence of rooms widely regarded as the finest and most complete expression of later Georgian taste". Inside the castle walls is the 15th-century

St George's Chapel, considered by the historian John Martin Robinson to be "one of the supreme achievements of English Perpendicular Gothic" design

- After Windsor Castle Tour, return to London and proceed for Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Lunch, we will proceed for City tour of London.
- It includes the Westminster Abbey, the Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, Nelson's Column at Trafalgar Square, the statue of Eros at Piccadilly Circus and the symbolic Tower Bridge.



- After City Tour some free time for shopping at Oxford Street.
- Oxford Street is a major road in the City of Westminster in the West End of London, running from Tottenham Court Road to Marble Arch via Oxford Circus. It is Europe's busiest shopping street, with around half a million daily visitors, has approximately 300 shops.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Overnight in London.

Day 3:- Change of Guards Ceremony. Entrance to Madame Tussauds, Tower of London & London Eye.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, we will spend whole day in London.
- Our first stop will be at The Buckingham Palace to witness the Changing of the Guards (If Operational).



- Later we will proceed to Madame Tussauds Museum. Step into the spotlight at Madame Tussauds London with more than 150 lifelike figures of today's biggest stars.
- Stand alongside Earth's Mightiest Heroes in the Marvel Hall of Heroes, getting up close with iconic characters like Iron Man and Captain America.



- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch, proceed to Tower of London and have a look at "Kohinoor Diamond".



- Later, you will be taken for a beautiful ride of the one of the world's largest observatory wheel and London's most popular attraction, London Eye.
- Enjoy some free time at Thames River before proceeding for Dinner.
- Dinner at Indian restaurant.
- Overnight in London.

**Day 4:- Depart London. Visit to BAPS Swaminarayan Temple.
 Transfer to Stratford Upon Avon. Orientation Tour of Stratford Upon Avon.
 Transfer to Cotswolds. Orientation Tour of Cotswolds Villages. Arrive Cardiff.
 (Breakfast, Local Lunch & Dinner)**

- After Breakfast at the Hotel, checkout and proceed to BAPS Swaminarayan Mandir.

- Soak yourself in the divine locality of what is popularly known as the 'Neasden Temple', BAPS Shri Swaminarayan Mandir is a Hindu temple in Neasden, London. Built entirely using traditional methods and materials.
- After the Darshan, proceed to Stratford upon Avon (150 kms/ Approx. 2Hrs).
- It is the town where William Shakespeare was born and is buried. Every year, millions of people celebrate his life and work by visiting the town.
- Get ready for Orientation Tour of Stratford upon Avon and visit some of the most beautiful spots in this excellent tour.



- Visit to Shakespeare's birthplace to walk in Shakespeare's footsteps and explore the house where he was born and grew up. Hear tales of Shakespeare's family life, enjoy live theatre on demand and get up close to rare artefacts from the Trust's world class collections as you discover how the extraordinary William Shakespeare continues to shape our lives today.
- Next visit is Anne Hathaway's cottage. This beautiful little thatched farmhouse is the place where the Bard courted his bride and still to this day holds items or original furniture, including the Hathaway bed.
- Lunch at Local Restaurant.
- Post lunch, transfer to Cotswolds (53 kms / Approx. 1 Hr)
- It's a visit what is often agreed to be one of the most beautiful areas in the whole of the UK. Quaint villages and breathtaking scenery, the Cotswolds looks like it jumped off the pages of a storybook.



- Arrive Cotswolds and get ready for an Orientation Tour of Costwolds Villages.
- Visit to the pretty villages - Bibury, Burford, and Burton on the water in the Cotswolds.
- Bourton-on-the-Water, also known as 'Little Venice' due to its low bridges and stone banks, Burford is famous for its steep high street which sweeps downhill towards the River Windrush past Cotswold stone cottages, Georgian townhouses, a medieval church, shops, tearooms and historic pubs. Bibury is a must-visit for anyone looking to discover that classic 'cottagecore' aesthetic.
- Transfer to Cardiff (130 kms/ Approx. 2 Hrs).
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Arrive at hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Cardiff.

Day 5:- Cardiff City Tour with Guide and Entrance to Cardiff Castle. Evening free at Leisure. (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After having breakfast at hotel, proceed for City Tour of Cardiff with Guide.
- Explore The Principality Stadium, Visit Cardiff Central Library, Stroll Around the National Museum & Explore at Cardiff Bay.
- Later visit Cardiff Castle.



- Known as one of the most popular historical monuments of the city, the Cardiff Castle was built on foundations that date back to 50 AD, for the then richest man in the world, the 3rd Marquis of Bute.
- Don't forget to marvel at the amazing State Rooms here, which boast of beautiful stained glass windows, ornate interiors as well as detailed wood carvings.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- After city tour, transfer back to the hotel.
- Evening free at leisure.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, transfer back to the hotel.
- Overnight in Cardiff.

Day 6:- Depart Cardiff / Arrive Birmingham. Cadbury World with 4D Adventure. Depart Birmingham / Arrive Manchester. City tour of Manchester with Guide. (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- Overnight at Manchester.

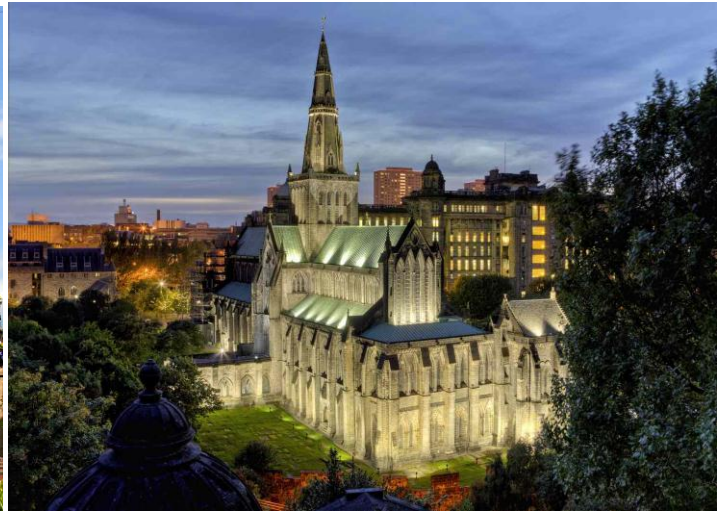
**Day 7:- Depart Manchester. Arrive Windermere. 01 Hour Lake Cruise.

You can see paintings, prints and photographs displayed alongside a wealth of historic artifacts, film, and computer interactives.
- Stroll down Buchanan street - main pedestrianized shopping are and take in the views from Glasgow Green.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.



- Post dinner, transfer to the hotel.
- Arrive at hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Glasgow.

**Day 8:- Guided City Tour of Edinburgh. Visit to Edinburgh Castle.
Free time at Luss Village, Loch Lomond Cruise.**

- Arrive Edinburgh, which has been the capital of Scotland since the 15th century.

- Edinburgh Castle is a historic fortress which dominates the skyline of the city of Edinburgh, Scotland, from its position on the Castle Rock. Archaeologists have established human occupation of the rock since at least the Iron Age (2nd century AD), although the nature of the early settlement is unclear.



- After visit of Castle, we depart from Edinburgh and head towards Glasgow.
- Enroute, Photo-stop at the Luss Village.



- A settlement has stood on this village since medieval times although much of the current village dates from the 18th and 19th centuries, having been developed to house workers from nearby slate quarries.
- Free time to explore the local area.
- Later continue towards Loch Lomond.
- Embark the Loch Lomond cruise. Sit back and relax on this hour-long trip on what is known as the Queen of Scottish Lochs. Enjoy spectacular views of the magnificent Ben Lomond and the highland boundary fault line as you enter into the Scottish Highlands from the Lowlands.
- Evening back to Glasgow.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Overnight in Glasgow.

Day 9:- Visit Riverside Museum. Depart Glasgow / Ferry to Belfast.

(Breakfast & Dinner)

- Today after Breakfast, Checkout from the hotel and proceed to visit the Riverside Museum - Glasgow's award-winning transport and technology museum.
- It houses one of the greatest collections of transport and technology in the UK. It is Hyper-modern museum with collections of historic vehicles and state-of-the-art interactive displays.



- Later drive to Cairnryan to board the ferry for Belfast.

- Arrive Belfast and proceed for Dinner at Indian Restaurant.

Depart Belfast / Arrive Dublin.**

- After City Tour proceed to visit the Titanic Belfast, a visitor attraction opened in 2012, a monument to Belfast's maritime heritage on the site of the former Harland & Wolff shipyard in the city's Titanic Quarter where the RMS Titanic was built. It tells the stories of the Titanic, which hit an iceberg and sank during her maiden voyage in 1912, and her sister ships RMS Olympic and HMHS Britannic.
- Later transfer to Indian Restaurant for Lunch.
- Post lunch Free time for leisure and Shopping in Belfast before we head towards Dublin.
- Arrive Dublin and proceed for Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, arrive at hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Dublin.

**Day 11:- City Tour of Dublin with Guide. Guinness Store House.
Free time at Temple Bar / Grafton Street. (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner)**

- Today after breakfast at the Hotel, proceed for a guided city tour of Dublin.

- Evening free for leisure or stroll through the Grafton Street.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant. Post dinner back to hotel.
- Overnight in Dublin

Day 12:- Depart Dublin / Arrive Home.

(Breakfast)

- Today after breakfast, check out from the hotel & whole group will get single transfer to Dublin Airport for our flight back home, collecting all of those wonderful memories and souvenirs gathered from England, Scotland, Ireland & Wales Holidays.
