Day 1:- Arrive Hanoi. Visit Train Street Café. Hanoi City Tour with Cyclo Tour. Evening free time for Shopping. Stay in World's First Gold Plated Hotel in Hanoi.

- Pickup from Airport and transfer to Indian Restaurant for Breakfast.
- After breakfast, we will visit the unique Train Street Café.



- Train Street Café a must-visit spot with a small caveat. It's a narrow alley where trains run right between houses and cafés, Hanoi Train Street is an Instagram must. Enjoy a cup of coffee as the train passes by, then explore the charismatic back streets and try a local snack.
- Then, visit to the Hoan Kiem Lake and Ngoc Son temple.
- Proceed to Temple of Literature built in 1070 and regarded as the First University in Vietnam. It is a temple dedicated to Confucius in Hanoi, northern Vietnam. It honours Vietnam's finest scholars, and also offers visitors a chance to see a rare example of well-preserved traditional Vietnamese architecture.
- After Hanoi City Tour, transfer to Hotel and Check-in. (Check-in time from 2PM onwards)
- Lunch on your own.
- Enjoy the stay in lovely gold-plated hotel. Experience luxury and get awed by the lovely décor in all gold plating.



- Later in the evening, we will proceed for Cyclo Tour at the Old Quarter to experience the exciting local daily life of Hanoians. You'll have a chance to explore Hanoi architectures, local life and traffics.
- Some free time for shopping and then proceed for Dinner.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, back to hotel.
- Overnight in Hanoi.

Day 2:- Depart Hanoi. Photostop at Lao Cai International Border Gate with China. Arrive Sapa. Visit Silver Waterfall & Cat Cat Village. (Approx 06 Hours Drive) (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, checkout and drive to Sapa. Sapa is around 06 Hours drive from Hanoi.
- Enroute, Photostop at Lao Cai Border Gate.
- Lao Cai International Border Gate Ha Khau is one of three international border gates, which are important in economic and trade exchanges across the land border between the Socialist Republic of Vietnam and the People's Republic of China. The Lao Cai International Border Area under Lao Cai IP was formed with the area of over 60 km2, including the wards and communes of Lao Cai, Coc Leu, Duyen Hai, Pho Moi, Kim Tan and Van. Hoa, Dong Tuyen in Lao Cai city and Na Mo village in Ban Phiet commune of Bao Thang district.
- Later continue with journey to Sapa.



- The Sapa region is prominent for its picture-perfect mountain landscapes and the diverse cultures of tribes like the Red Dzao, Hmong, and Phu La ethnic groups. Sapa's a must-visit if you want breathtaking are rice paddies, easy going hikes, and a chance to experience Vietnam's diverse ethnic groups.
- Arrive Sapa and proceed for Lunch at Indian Restaurant
- Post lunch, we will visit the Silver Waterfall. It is high in the hills.



- At 1800m, it is at the foot of the Tram Ton Pass. At around 12km from Sapa, it is visible from Ham Rong Mountain peak. The waterfall is surrounded by a stunning array of rugged limestone and a tremendous range of fauna. It's about 200m in height. The water can flow fast down these falls. This flow creates a silver-like gleam in the water. It looks like silver from a distance.
- Next, visit Cat Cat Village. Traditional handicrafts, cultural performances, and trekking opportunities make it a worth to visit. The terraced rice fields and cascading waterfalls add to the picturesque setting.
- You can admire beautiful landscapes and have more experiences of tribe people here with black H'mong people and discover their real life.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Dinner, arrive at hotel and Check-in.

• Overnight in Sapa.

<u>Day 3</u>:- Visit Fansipan Mountain with Two Way Cable Car. Depart Sapa / Arrive Hanoi. (Approx 06 Hours Drive)

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, check out and get ready to discover the Fansipan Mountain.
- A breathtaking experience awaits at the top of Mt. Fansipan, the highest peak in Vietnam. Its nickname is "The Roof of Indochina". Take the three-rope cable car system which carries you from the bottom to the highest point of the mountain in 15-20 minutes. From there, you can enjoy the scenery and magnificent views of the Sapa area and beautiful landscape of Lai Chau province.



- Enjoy Jaw-dropping views of swirling clouds and forested slopes from the top of Fansipan.
- Later back to base in Cable Car.
- Proceed for Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch, transfer back to Hanoi (Approx 06 Hours Drive).
- Arrive at Hanoi and Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Dinner, arrive at hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Hanoi.

Day 4:- Depart Hanoi / Arrive Halong Bay (Approx 3.5 Hours Drive) Experience Spectacular Seaplane Ride. Transfer to Halong Bay Cruise.

(Breakfast, Local Lunch & Local Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, checkout and transfer to Halong Bay.
- 3.5 hours' journey is scenic in itself alongside beautiful landscape of Red River delta.

- The moment of take-off is a highlight on every ride. The seaplane gets to speed and lifts off in fewer than 60 seconds. Landings are just as dramatic, as the seaplane touches down on the glimmering water of Tuan Chau Marina, cruises over the ripples and climbs ashore.



- Later board Halong Bay Cruise.
- Upon arrival at the Harbour, meet our Cruise Crew to join the fantastic journey around the New Seven Wonder on Luxury Cruise. Welcomed and check-in the boat, your local lunch will be served while the boat slowly slides on romantic waves of the sea.
- Afternoon is time for many interesting activities such as: visiting the cave, kayaking, swimming, sunbathing & cooking class.

- You should not miss walking on the Golden Bridge amid the foggy hills of the mountain, enjoy the gorgeous view of Da Nang City.
- Lunch at Restaurant.



- In the afternoon, Visit Fantasy Park in Danang.
- Multiple indoor and outdoor facilities of world standards are available in the park. It won't be wrong to say that it is the first of its kind and equipped with entertaining and joyful activities.
- The Fantasy Park complex is divided into three main flours. Games, thrills, attractions, cinemas 3D, 4D and 5D with 360-degree mega modern cameras are installed in the park and there is no competitor of it in Vietnam. A 29-meter free-fall tower has increased the beauty of the park.



- Dinner at Indian restaurant.
- Overnight in Danang.

Day 7:- Visit The Marble Mountain and Linh Ung Pagoda. Basket Boat Ride. Evening Hoi An Town with Lantern Boat Ride.

- After breakfast at hotel, proceed to visit The Marble Mountains.
- Welcome to Marble Mountains. This riveting attraction outside Da Nang City is part historical treasure, part natural wonder, part spiritual setting, and totally beautiful.



- Marble Mountains is a group of five limestone peaks situated seven kilometres from downtown Da Nang. The five karsts (called Ngu Hanh Son in Vietnamese) are named after the five elements: Kim (metal), Thuỷ (water), Mộc (wood), Hoả (fire) and Thổ (earth).
- Later we will visit Linh Ung Pagoda.
- Linh Ung Bai But pagoda was placed the first stone on June 19th, 2004 lunar, after 6 years of construction, on July 30th, 2010, the pagoda was official inaugurated. Linh Ung Bai But pagoda is considered as a work stamped development footprint of Buddhism in Vietnam in the XXI century and a meeting place of heaven and earth's sacred air and people's heart.
- Being the tallest Buddha statue in Vietnam, Lady Buddha Da Nang is located at Linh Ung Pagoda on Son Tra Peninsula in Da Nang. Lady Buddha Da Nang statue is inside Linh Ung pagoda courtyard with a height of 67m, the lotus diameter is 35m, equivalent to a 30-storey building.
- Lunch on your own.
- Later, transfer for Basket Boat Ride. Enjoy the most unique attraction of Vietnam.



- Later proceed for orientation tour of Hoi An.
- This only remains of Japanese culture is now considered as a symbol of Hoi An. Taking a walk on the street along the Hoai River, enjoy the night life of Hoi An Town. Colourful lanterns are hung on in front of the houses, across the streets and paths all around the town, which is going to make you feel peaceful, serene and want to last this walk forever. Our tour ends with mesmerizing Lanter Boat Ride. Immerse yourself in Hoi An extraordinary local culture on this trip by night boat. Travel through the city, and feel the magical sensation of release your own lantern to the sky as your destination.
- Dinner at Indian restaurant.
- Overnight in Danang.

Day 8:- Depart Danang / Arrive Hochiminh City (Saigon). Landmark 81 Skydeck Entrance.

- After breakfast at hotel, morning free for leisure.

- Later check out from hotel and take flight to Ho Chi Minh City (Saigon).

- We will then proceed to visit Landmark 81. Landmark 81 is a supertall skyscraper in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam. It is primarily invested and developed by Vinhomes, the largest vietnamese real-estate developer.

- Landmark 81 holds the position of the tallest building in Vietnam, the second tallest building in Southeast Asia, as well as the seventeenth tallest building in the world overall.
- The 461.2-metre (1,513 ft) tall, 81-story building is located at the western banks of the Saigon River in Binh Thanh District, the north side of Ho Chi Minh City's historic center



- Experience panoramic views of Saigon from a height of 390 meters at Landmark 81's Saigon Skyview, the tallest building in Vietnam.
- Dinner at Indian restaurant.
- Post Dinner arrive at Hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Ho Chi Minh.

Day 9:- Cu Chi Tunnels & Evening Shopping Tour.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

• After breakfast. We will proceed for the famous attraction of Cu Chi Tunnels.



- Cu Chi is the amazing site where Viet Cong hid during the War. It is now a popular spot for both Vietnamese and foreign tourists the network of over 200km of tunnels became legendary when they played a vital role in the War. In their heyday, the tunnels were functioning underground cities including numerous trap doors, specially constructed living areas, storage facilities, weapons factories, field hospitals, command centres & kitchens.
- There is plenty of evidence of the fierce battle that took place here during the 1960s when Cu Chi was a "Free Target Zone". Visitors can watch a short introductory video showing how the tunnels were constructed before entering the tunnels. Spend the next hour exploring the tunnels. Afterwards, enjoy tea, cassava (guerrilla's food in war time).
- Return to Ho Chi Minh City and Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Rest of the day is free for shopping at famous local market of Ho Chi Minh City.
- Dinner at Indian restaurant.
- Overnight in Ho Chi Minh.

<u>Day 10</u>:- Checkout from Hote. Ho Chi Min City Tour with War Remnants Museum. Depart Ho Chi Minh / Arrive Home.

(Breakfast & Lunch)

- After breakfast, checkout from hotel.
- We will then proceed for City Tour of Ho Chi Minh.



- Start Ho Chi Minh City tour with a visit to the Reunification Hall which includes: formal meeting rooms, private bedrooms, war situation rooms 10 meter beneath earth's level. Get versed with important historical facts about this building and some French colonial structures, the Notre Dame Cathedral, General Post Office, The City Hall and the last one is Opera House.
- Take an entrance to The War Remnants Museum. It's a must visit for anyone wanting to understand more about the Vietnam war and its effects. War Remnant Museum leaves nothing to the imagination and puts front and centre the horrors of First Indochina War and the Vietnam War.
- After City Tour, proceed for Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Lunch, transfer to airport for flight back home with wonderful memories & souvenirs from your Vietnam Holidays.
