### **Day 1:- Arrive Barcelona Airport. Transfer to Hotel & Check-in. Evening free for leisure at Ra Lamba Street.**

**(Lunch & Dinner)**

- Arrive at Barcelona International Airport, clear immigration and proceed to the hotel.
- Barcelona is one of Europe's trendiest cities. It's a hub of new trends in the world of culture, fashion and cuisine. It combines the creativity of its artists and designers with respect and care for local traditions.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Lunch, transfer to the hotel and Check-in. Take rest and freshen up.
- In the evening, enjoy free time for leisure at Barcelona's famous La Rambla Street. The melting pot of street artists, musicians, museums, and markets creates a lively and tangible cultural experience.



- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Transfer back to the hotel.
- Overnight in Barcelona.

**Day 2:- Full Day City Tour of Barcelona with Guide. Visit Sagrada Familia.  
Evening free time at Gothic Quarter.**

**(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)**

- Today After breakfast, full day to explore the beautiful city of Barcelona.
- We will start our day with City Tour of Barcelona with Guide.
- Explore the incredible history of Barcelona's Gothic Quarter and tour Passeig de Gracia, an elegant boulevard with a wealth of modernist architecture like Gaudí's La Pedrera and Casa Batlló.
- We will continue with our city tour and proceed to visit The Sagrada Familia, which is a Roman-Catholic basilica, is Barcelona's most famous landmark.



- Its official Catalan name is "Temple Expiatori de la Sagrada Família" which means "Temple of Atonement of the Holy Family" in English. Construction work began in 1882 and was later lead by Antoni Gaudí in 1883 who introduced the art style of Modernisme into the design of the basilica.

The Sagrada Familia is projected to be completed on Gaudí's 100th death anniversary in 2026. The construction of the Sagrada Familia is exclusively financed by donations and funds from foundations and Catholic groups. The Sagrada Familia boasts of unbelievable spatial dimensions, complex embellishments, and magnificent facades & doors- and it should have 18 bell towers by the completion of the construction. On 7 November 7th 2010, Pope Benedikt XVI consecrated the Sagrada Familia and elevated it to the status "basilica."



- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Evening free time at Gothic Quarter - made up of narrow streets and squares that reflect Barcelona's medieval past with the presence of palaces, residences and Gothic churches. The historic center of the city is an architectural jewel. It is a living testimony to the city's rich cultural heritage.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, back to hotel.
- Overnight in Barcelona.

**Day 3:- Depart Barcelona / Flight to Ibiza. Arrive Ibiza. Evening free for Leisure. (Breakfast & Dinner)**

- After breakfast at hotel, check out from the hotel and transfer to Airport for your flight to Ibiza.



- Ibiza, a sun-soaked Mediterranean paradise, offers an enchanting blend of vibrant nightlife, stunning beaches, and rich cultural heritage. Renowned for its world-class clubs and lively party scene, this idyllic island also boasts serene landscapes, charming villages, and UNESCO-listed sites.  
Arrive Ibiza airport and transfer to the hotel.
- Arrive at hotel and Check in.
- Rest of the day is free for leisure.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner back to hotel.
- Overnight in Ibiza.

#### Day 4:- Day Trip to Formentera by Private Yacht.

#### (Breakfast & Local Snacks in Cruise)

- After Breakfast, proceed for a Day Trip to Formentera by Private Yacht.
- Formentera is the smallest among the Balearic Islands and is located 19 km south of Ibiza. It is a beautiful and laid-back destination where you can enjoy the sun and the sea. You can travel to Formentera from Ibiza or mainland Spain exclusively by yacht, as there is no airport on the island. The Ibiza - Formentera ferry route is quite popular for day trips, especially in the summer.



- Snacks with soft drinks and beer is included.
- Crystal clear waters, white beaches with a Caribbean flair and small coves framed by high wooded cliffs are the setting for a perfect sailing area, where you will find a unique combination of nature, gastronomy and exclusive leisure. Jump into the crystal clear and turquoise water, have fun with our SUP boards and of course take pictures for the gram.
- We will meet at around 12noon and from there we will get the tender to the sailing yacht.
- From there we will offer you a welcome drink before setting sail to Formentera. On arrival in Formentera you are free to explore the islands beaches, relax onboard or go to visit the famous chiringuitos for lunch. On the sailboat you will also have access to paddle board and snorkelling equipment. The experience will start at 12.00 pm and will finish around 8pm.
- Transfer back to hotel.
- Dinner on your own,

- Overnight in Ibiza.

### **Day 5:- Depart Ibiza / Flight to Malaga. Evening free for leisure.**

**(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)**

- After breakfast at hotel, check out from the hotel and transfer to Airport for your flight to Malaga.
- It is one of the oldest cities in Spain and a lot of its rich past still remains. Malaga offers experiences to suit all tastes, styles and moments. The Old Town still has its old charm and cobbled streets; you will also find a Roman Amphitheatre located on a mountain side.
- Arrive Malaga Airport and transfer to the hotel.
- Enroute Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Arrive at hotel and Check in.
- Rest of the day is free for leisure.
- Explore Malaga on your own.



- Later in the evening, proceed for Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner back to hotel.
- Overnight in Malaga.

### **Day 6:- Day Trip to Caminito del Rey with Guide.**

**(Breakfast & Dinner)**

- After breakfast at hotel, proceed for guided tour to Caminito del Rey.
- Get ready for - the unique experience of strolling along walkways hanging over 100 metres up on a sheer cliff face. The views are unforgettable.
- The Caminito del Rey route is spectacular from beginning to end, running through cliffs, canyons, and a large valley. It crosses the landscapes of Desfiladero de los Gaitanes, a gorge carved out by the river Guadalhorce, with walls 700 metres high. The area is also inhabited by a wide variety of plant and animal species; with a little luck, you can see highland birds like Egyptian vultures, griffon vultures, or golden eagles, and mammals such as wild boar and Iberian ibex.
- The trail is linear and taken one way only, going downwards and from north to south, some of it on mountain paths and some on suspended walkways. It's 7.7 kilometres long and takes about 3-4 hours to walk, from the start in the town of Ardales to the exit in Álora.



- The viewing point on Gaitanejo dam has views of the cave dwellings of Sierra Parida, which were once home to the staff working at the hydroelectric plant. After reaching the walkways, the trail continues through the Gaitanejo gorge, the canyon known as Tajo de las Palomas, and the hanging bridge, Puente del Rey. The landscape gradually changes as you approach the Hoyo valley with its leafy woodland.
- Next, the path enters the spectacular gorge of Los Gaitanes via walkways suspended 100 metres above the ground. The amazing sights on this stretch include a hundred-year-old juniper tree growing among the rocks, the “fossil beach” with Jurassic-period fossils, and a glass balcony which sticks out from the walkway, for those who feel they need to push their limits.



- Transfer back to Malaga.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner back to hotel.
- Overnight in Malaga.

**Day 7:- Depart Malaga / Arrive Seville. Evening Flamenco Show with Local Dinner.  
(Breakfast, Lunch & Local Dinner)**

- After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to Seville.
- Arrive Seville and proceed for lunch.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Arrive Seville and transfer to the hotel.
- Arrive at hotel and Check in. Take Rest and Freshen up.

- Later in the evening, experience the best of Spain – Flamenco Show.



- Flamenco Show offers authentic performances for an experience which embodies the magic and charm of this ancestral part of Spanish culture.
- The show is approximately one hour and ten minutes and features four to five artists. The performance includes several of the most representative styles of flamenco such as the primitive darkness of la tona and el martinete or the majestic dance of solea. Included are the more festive rumbas and bulerias as well as the beauty of sevillanas. The show is a unique journey through the world of flamenco performed by a collection of talented performers.
- 01 Drink and Local Dinner included with Show.
- Transfer back to the hotel.
- Overnight in Seville.

**Day 8:- Full Day for Seville Sightseeing. Horse Carriage Ride. City Tour of Seville with Guide. Free time at Plaza De La Encarnacion. Optional Sky Diving**

**(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)**

- You may go for Optional Sky Diving for this day. Sky diving activity needs to be pre booked as limited slots are available. More info can be found on website <https://www.skydivespain.com/>
- After breakfast at hotel, proceed for full day Seville sightseeing.
- At First, enjoy Horse Carriage Ride. Booking a horse drawn carriage tour around Seville is one of the most romantic things you can do, especially at dusk. It's just magic.
- Enjoy a relaxed and picturesque panoramic ride, passing iconic landmarks like the tobacco factory and the Alfonso XIII Hotel. Explore key attractions, including the Cathedral, Giralda, and Royal Alcazar, in a fun and leisurely manner.
- See the top landmarks of Seville from a horse-drawn carriage during this private tour. Learn about city history from your English-speaking guide while admiring attractions such as Plaza de Espana.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Get ready for a City Tour of Seville.
- We can't miss photo stop at Seville Cathedral & Alcazar.
- The Seville Cathedral is known for housing the longest nave among all the cathedrals of Spain. The Alcazar in Seville is a very impressive Moorish palace, and also has huge and impressive gardens (which are incredibly peaceful).
- Your visit to Seville will not be completed without visiting at Plaza Espana, Torre De Oro (exterior), Barrio Santa Cruz and view of Guadalquivir river.



- Spend free time in Plaza De La Encarnacion, which used to be a car park but has been transformed by a new piece of architecture the Metropol Parasol. You can walk along a walkway at the top to see the roof tops of old town Seville. There are Great shops nearby and plenty of tapas in la Feria nearby.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Transfer back to the hotel.
- Overnight in Seville.

**Day 9:- Depart Seville / Arrive Madrid. (534 kms / Approx 5 Hours).**

**Visit Las Ventas Bull Ring. Evening free for Shopping at Gran Via.**

**(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)**

- After breakfast at hotel, checkout and transfer to Madrid.
- Madrid is the capital and most populous city of Spain. It is the second-largest city in the European Union (EU).
- Arrive Madrid and proceed for Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Proceed to visit Las Ventas Bull Ring - the largest bullfighting ring in Spain.



- It's a cultural experience like no other. The actual area is fantastic and worth a visit even if you choose not to see a fight. It was inaugurated on June 17, 1931. Its seating capacity of 23,798, makes it the third-largest bullfighting run in the world, after bullrings in Mexico and Venezuela. After the federal ban of bullfighting in Plaza México, Las Ventas is the second largest bullring in the world still in operation for its original intention.
- Later some free time in Gran Via / City Centre for shopping. Gran Via is the busiest, most popular street in Madrid. It's 1300m long and more than 100 years old, and lined with some of the most sought-after retail shops in town – a true open-air shopping mall, drawing over 10 million people every year.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, arrive at Hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Madrid.

**Day 10:- City Tour of Madrid with Guide. Visit Royal Palace of Madrid.  
Evening Walking Tour of Toledo with Guide.**

**(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)**

- Today after breakfast, proceed for a Full Day Tour of Madrid and Toledo with Guide.
- We will start with City Tour of Madrid.



- This will allow you to get a glimpse of some of Madrid's most outstanding attractions. Our guide will explain all about important places of Madrid and will stop at Templo de Debod and Los Jeronimos.
- Moreover, it's not long until you reach The Royal Palace Madrid, the official residence of the kings of Spain. Marvel at the main staircase by Sabatini, the Throne Room, the Hall of Alabarderos, the Royal Chapel, and more. The palace has 1,450,000 sq ft of floor space and contains 3,418 rooms. It is the largest royal palace in Europe.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Lunch, transfer to Toledo.
- We will start our Toledo City Tour with Guide and experience photo-stop at Toledo Cathedral, View of Tagus River and Plaza de Zocodover.
- The Plaza de Zocodover is a hub of activity and events in the heart of Toledo. It is surrounded on all sides by a range of impressive buildings and cafés. Relax with a coffee and people-watch in this lively plaza, a short walk west from the Tagus River.



- Proceed to visit to Sword Shops. Toledo has been a traditional sword-making, metal-working center since about the Roman period, and came to the attention of Rome when used by Hannibal in the Punic Wars. It soon became a standard source of weaponry for Roman legions.
- Return back to Madrid and proceed for Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Overnight in Madrid.

**Day 11:- Visit Bernabeu Stadium & Real Madrid Museum with Guide.  
Evening Free for Leisure.**

**(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)**

- Today after breakfast, proceed to visit Bernabeu Stadium - an absolute must on your trip to Madrid.
- It is a retractable roof football stadium in Madrid, Spain. With a seating capacity of 78,297 the stadium has the second-largest seating capacity for a football stadium in Spain.
- The tour includes access to an incredible panoramic view of the stadium and the Real Madrid CF Museum, where you can relive glorious nights through priceless objects, including their 14 Champions League titles. A must see!



- Learn more about the magnificent history of the world's most successful club, and experience first-hand the historical transformation of the Santiago Bernabéu Stadium.
