Day 1:- Arrive Tokyo. Evening Free for Leisure.

(Dinner)

- Welcome to Tokyo, Japan.
- Arrive Narita/Haneda International Airport, clear immigration and proceed to the hotel.
- Tokyo is Japan's capital and the world's most populous metropolis cosmopolitan city with a blend of High tech & culture. Tokyo dazzles with its traditional culture and passion for everything. You cannot visit the same Tokyo twice. The city is always changing in fun, unpredictable ways and creates new styles by mixing modernity and tradition more than any one sight.
- Arrive Tokyo hotel and Check-in. (Check-in from 3 PM onwards)



- Rest of the evening is free for leisure.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, back to hotel.
- Overnight in Tokyo.

Day 2:- Full Day Tokyo City Tour. Shinjuku Gyoen National Garden, Asakusa Temple. Sumida River Cruise, Odaiba Statue of Liberty & Tokyo Tower.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, we will proceed for full day sightseeing of Tokyo.
- Full Day Tokyo City Tour with Guide will cover all important landmarks of Tokyo.
- Our first stop will be at Shinjuku Gyoen National Garden.
- Shinjuku Gyoen is a large garden, originally built for the Imperial Family. There are 65 types of cherry blossoms, about 1,100 trees in all, planted in the garden, and it might be fun to try and find out the differences between them. Visitors can enjoy three different types of gardens: the French Garden, with its beautiful tree-lined avenues, the English Landscape Garden, which has a spacious lawn, and the traditional Japanese-style Garden.



- Visit to Asakusa Temple where you can marvel at the thousands-year-old temple of Senso-ji, backdropped by the science-fiction-style Tokyo Skytree.
- Enjoy some free time at Nakamise Shopping Street which is one of Japan's oldest shopping streets. There are About 90 stalls selling souvenirs, traditional goods and snacks line the street in Asakusa.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.



- Post lunch, we will continue with our Tokyo City Tour.
- Enjoy a relaxing cruise on the Sumida River. Sumida River Cruise is an enjoyable alternative to cover the beautiful destinations of glorious Tokyo. It is a matter of joy to conveniently cover the entertaining

and shopping area of Tokyo's man made islands through this water raft. This sophisticated cruise ride surely offers you a memorable moment.

- Head to Odaiba, drive by Rainbow Bridge. Enjoy a visit to Odaiba Statue of liberty – a symbol of the Japan-France friendship. Though it's positioning in front of the nearby Rainbow Bridge gives off the impression that this recreation is to scale, in reality, it's about 1/7th of the size of the New York original.



- We can't finish our day in Tokyo without visit to Tokyo Tower.
- With 333 meters, Tokyo Tower is 13 meters taller than its model, the Eiffel Tower of Paris, and the world's tallest self-supporting steel tower. It was completed in the year 1958 as a symbol for Japan's rebirth as a major economic power and serves as a television and radio broadcast antenna and tourist attraction.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, back to hotel.
- Overnight in Tokyo.

**Day 3:- Full Day Tokyo Sightseeing. Visit Chidorigafuchi Park & Meiji Shrine.
Tokyo Bay Aqualine Experience. Visit Teamlab Borderless.**

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, we will proceed for 2nd day of Tokyo Sightseeing.
- Our tour will start with visit of Chidorigafuchi Park.
- It is one of the most beautiful cherry-blossom-viewing spots in the city as well as a scenic and relaxing spot year-round. This natural moat played a role in the decision to build Edo Castle in this location. It's A 700-meter-long lush green walkway along the moat of the Imperial Palace, and one of the top spots in Tokyo for viewing cherry blossoms.
- You can rent a rowboat to explore the moat.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch, we will experience Tokyo Bay Aqualine.

- The Tokyo Bay Aqua-Line, also known as the Trans-Tokyo Bay Expressway, is an expressway that is mainly made up of a bridge–tunnel combination across Tokyo Bay in Japan.
- An artificial island, Umihotaru marks the transition between the bridge and tunnel segments and provides a rest stop with restaurants, shops, and amusement facilities. A distinctive tower standing above the middle of the tunnel, the Kaze no Tō supplies air to the tunnel, its ventilation system powered by the bay's almost-constant winds.
- We will then proceed to Meiji Shrine.
- Meiji Shrine is a Shinto shrine in Shibuya, Tokyo, that is dedicated to the deified spirits of Emperor Meiji and his wife, Empress Shōken.



- The shrine's daily ceremonies, incredible architecture, and scenic grounds make it a memorable and rejuvenating destination for tourists and Shinto practitioners alike.
- Last but not the least - wander, explore, and discover in One Continuous Borderless World TeamLab Borderless.



- It is a world of artworks without boundaries, a museum without a map created by art collective TeamLab. Artworks move out of rooms, relate to other works, influence each other, and at times intermingle, without boundaries. Immerse your body in borderless art.

- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, back to hotel.
- Overnight in Tokyo.

**Day 4:- Depart Tokyo. Visit Mt. Fuji 5th Station. Lake Ashi Cruise. Hakone Owakudani Ropeway. Bullet Train Experience to Nagano (02h50m). Arrive Nagano.
(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)**

- After breakfast, checkout from hotel and proceed to Mt Fuji & Hakone.
- We first start with visit to Mt. Fuji (Fujisan) which stand at 3776 meters, is Japan's highest mountain. Out of 8 station, only till 5th station Tourist Bus can go and we will see Mt. Fuji from there only.
- Mt. Fuji's exceptionally symmetrical cone, which is snow-capped for about five months of the year is commonly used as a cultural icon of Japan and it is frequently depicted in art and photography. It's surprising that the nearly perfectly shaped volcano has been worshipped as a sacred mountain and experienced big popularity among artists and common people.



- After visit of Mt. Fuji, proceed for Lunch.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch we will proceed to visit Lake Ashi.



- Lake Ashi or Hakone Lake, a scenic lake in the Hakone area of Kanagawa Prefecture in Japan and enjoy scenic cruise on the Lake. It is a crater lake that lies along the southwest wall of the caldera of Mount Hakone, a complex volcano. The lake is known for its views of Mt. Fuji and its numerous hot springs. A number of pleasure boats and ferries traverse the lake and providing scenic views for tourists and passengers.
- Enjoy Owakudani Ropeway to experience one of the greatest expanses of natural scenery in Japan! Traveling from Sounzan to Owakudani, passengers can see the bottom of the valley below, and, when on route to Togendai, they can enjoy views of Mt. Fuji and Lake Ashi.
- Later, transfer to Odawara station to board Bullet Train to Nagano.
- Nagano's landscape is defined by the towering mountains of the Japanese Alps. 15 out of 23 of Japan's 3,000-meter-high mountains are here, earning Nagano the nickname, "the Roof of Japan."
- Arrive Nagano and proceed for dinner.
Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, arrive at Hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Nagano.

**Day 5:- Depart Nagano. Alpine Tour with Snow Corridor. Arrive Kanazawa.
(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)**

- After breakfast at hotel, check out and get ready to depart for Alpine Tour with Snow Corridor.
- Tateyama Kurobe Alpine Route is a mountain route through the Northern Japan Alps. Known as the "Roof of Japan," it is a must-visit for nature lovers and thrill-seekers. From cable cars to electric buses to a ropeway, this exciting trek through Mt. Tateyama showcases the beauty of the Japan Alps while taking you on a thrilling ride through an elevation change of 2400 meters.
- Led by an English-speaking guide, you will be accompanied on your journey to the Roof of Japan and back down again - the perfect way to experience one of Japan's more remote and stunning landscapes.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.



- From Ogisawa, board the trolley bus and begin your ascent toward the summit using a number of mountain vehicles including trolley bus, cable car and Tateyama Ropeway - which at 1700 meters long.
- Experience the dramatic mountain landscape of Chubu Sangaku National Park and visit the immense Snow Walls of the Tateyama Kurobe Alpine Route. These giant snowdrifts stand 20 meters high along the Tateyama Kurobe Alpine Route.

- Reach the summit of 2,450 meters above sea level and access the 'Roof of Japan'. Witness the dramatic alpine landscape of Japan's highest mountain by walking through the snowfields. Look closely, you might spot the bird ptarmigan - once revered as a messenger of the gods - camouflaged against the snow.
- Transfer to Kanazawa.
- Kanazawa is sometimes called "little Kyoto". It's packed with first-rate sights, including one of the country's best gardens, some great museums and several beautifully preserved neighborhoods. Traditional arts and crafts thrived for centuries in Kanazawa, so it is no wonder the city is known for them even today.
- Arrive Kanazawa and proceed for dinner.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner arrive at Hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Kanazawa.

**Day 6:- Kanazawa Sightseeing with Visit to Kenrokuen Garden.
Depart Kanazawa / Transfer to Nagoya (Approx. 3.15hrs).
Visit Nabano na Sato. Arrive Kyoto.**

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, we will proceed for Kanazawa Sightseeing.
- Visit Kenrokuen Garden. It is justifiably ranked as one of Japan's "three most beautiful gardens" alongside Mito's Kairakuen and Okayama's Korakuen. The spacious grounds used to be the outer garden of Kanazawa Castle. It features a variety of flowering trees which provide the garden with a different look every season.
- Feel the power and influence of the Lords of Kanazawa by visiting the Kanazawa Castle grounds and park area. View the beautiful white lead roof tiles, touch the formidable Ishikawa Mon gate, and enjoy the tranquility of Lord Maeda's personal gardens.
- The Kanazawa Samurai District tour takes you back in time to one of the best preserved Samurai Districts in Japan. The streets are lined with mud & straw walls encapsulating the unspoilt extravagance of the Samurai era. Let us take you through this romantic enclave on a trip back in time.
- Transfer to Nagoya by coach.



- Nagoya, capital of Japan's Aichi Prefecture, is a manufacturing and shipping hub in central Honshu. There is a lot to see and do in Nagoya, from traditional and ancient castles and museums to modern entertainment and theme parks.
- Arrive Nagoya & Proceed for Lunch at Indian Restaurant.

- Visit Nabano no Sato - The flower village. It is one of Japan's finest and most famed winter illuminations with over 5.8 million LEDs, lighting up the darkness of a chilly winter night, creating romantic images of mountains, oceans, flowers, shapes and figures among immense flower gardens, along with open-air hot spring foot baths and spas, fine restaurants and shops.



- Drive to Kyoto.
- Arrive Kyoto and proceed for Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Arrive at Hotel and check in.
- Overnight in Kyoto.

Day 7:- Full Day Kyoto City Tour. Kimono Wearing Experience.
Visit Kinkakuji Temple – The Golden Pavillion. Enjoy Sagano Romantic Train Ride.
Visit Kiyomizudera Temple & Fushi Inari Shrine.
(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)


- After breakfast at hotel, we will proceed for Full Day Tour of Kyoto.
- At First, get ready to have a wonderful and memorable opportunity for you and your whole family. Come and find out what it's like to dress up in a traditional Japanese kimono!
- Kimono labelled as the "National Costume of Japan", is a beautiful item of traditional clothing, and is immediately associated with Japan. Wearing a kimono is a great way to gain an understanding of how it feels to dress in authentic Japanese clothing. Don't miss an opportunity to have memorable clicks in this wonderful clothing.



- Don't worry about how difficult the process of putting on a kimono is because an expert will be helping you all the way. Along with that you will learn more about the history of the kimono and how it has evolved over time. You can also learn some of the occasions for wearing kimono, and the different types of kimono that people wear.
- Continuing with City Tour, Kyoto is the home of renowned World Heritage sites such as Kinkakuji Temple.
- Kinkakuji Temple is famous for its spectacular architecture that uniquely harmonizes the culture and prevailing design of court nobles, samurai, and Buddhism.
- Later proceed for Sagano Romantic Train Ride. It takes approximately 25 minutes to cover the whole 7 km long trail which offers spectacular views of the wonderful scenery of Hozu River. Enjoy an exhilarating train ride while admiring the beauty of the Hozukyo gorge. The sheer beauty of the scenery spread out before you are bound to become an unforgettable memory.



- The train whisks you away from the comforts of everyday life and takes you on an extraordinary journey surrounded by the sounds of nature and gentle breeze. Perhaps you will be able to take a picture that could not be taken anywhere else.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.



- Post lunch, we will continue with visit to Kiyomizudera Temple. It is abundantly blessed with nature and offers a commanding view of the city. The temple's stage, supported by massive pillars, is one of

the most famous images of Japan. In harmony with the beautiful scenery of the ancient city, it is worth visiting to get there and cross beautiful pedestrian streets full of charm and a lot of history.

- Later visit Fushi Inara Shrine - a beautiful Shinto shrine in southern Kyoto, famous for its thousands of vermilion torii. The torii gates along the way are donations from individuals and companies and on the back of each gate is the name of the donor and the date of the donation.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner back to hotel.
- Overnight in Kyoto.

Day 8:- Depart Kyoto / Bullet Train Experience to Hiroshima (01h40m).

Hiroshima Sightseeing. Bullet Train Experience to Osaka (01h30m).

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, checkout and transfer to Kyoto Station to board Bullet train to Hiroshima.
- While it is probably most famous for being devastated by a nuclear attack at the close of World War II, the city is not morose or bitter about its past, and instead promotes peace and understanding. Between the history, culture, natural beauty, and delicious food, there are so many things to do in Hiroshima and Miyajima that you won't want to rush your visit.
- Arrive Hiroshima and proceed for sightseeing.
- Visit Peace Memorial Park which is defined both as a place for prayer for the atomic bomb victims as well as for permanent world peace.
- Visit The Atomic Bomb Dome which is having distinctive domed steel frame and was included in UNESCO's World Heritage List in December 1996 as a symbol of the devastation caused by the first atomic bomb in the history of humankind. It represents the importance of the abolition of nuclear weapons for everlasting world peace.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Visit Miyajima Island.



- Since ancient times, the island itself has been regarded as a God within the Japanese natural religion Shinto, and for centuries it was home to only wild animals and the occasional high priest. Miyajima is worth visiting for its beautiful landscapes, historic shrines, and wealth of history and culture.
- The island's most famous attraction is the 800-year-old Itsukushima Shrine.
- It is most famous for its dramatic gate, or torii on the outskirts of the shrine, the sacred peaks of Mount Misen, extensive forests, and its ocean view. The View of Itsukushima Shrine Torii is stunning.

- Later, we will board Bullet train to Osaka.
- Osaka is a charming, relaxed city best known for its food, fun and nightlife with some history and culture peeking through. This Japanese city, popularly known as the “kitchen of Japan,” is a place where a real foodie can experience a gastronomic feast.



- Arrive Osaka and proceed for dinner.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, arrive at hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Osaka.

**Day 9:- Day Excursion to Nara. Visit Todaiji Temple & Nara Deer Park.
Kasuga Taisha Shrine.**

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After Breakfast at hotel, proceed for Day Trip to Nara.
- Arrive Nara and proceed for local sightseeing.



- We will visit Todaiji Temple - one of Japan's most famous and historically significant temples and a landmark of Nara. The temple was constructed in 752 CE as the head temple of all provincial Buddhist temples of Japan and grew so powerful that the capital was moved from Nara to Nagaoka in 784 in order to lower the temple's influence on government affairs.
- Then we will visit Nara Deer Park - a must visit destination in Kyoto. The deers were just around and you get to experience to feed them first hand. There are Almost 1200 wild deer roam in Nara Park.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Visit Kasuga Taisha shrine. It is famous for Japan's largest number of lanterns, with 2,000 stone lanterns and 1,000 hanging lanterns within the shrine premises.
- Later transfer to Osaka.



- Arrive Osaka and proceed for dinner.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Dinner, back to hotel.
- Overnight in Osaka.

Day 10:- Full Day Osaka City Tour with Guide.

Visit Osaka Castle, Nishinomaru Garden. Umeda Sky Building.

Osaka Aquarium Kaiyukan. Free time at Dotonbori Shopping Street.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, we will proceed for Full Day Tour of Osaka.
- We will start with Osaka Castle - one of the most famous landmarks in Japan.
- Osaka Castle is known for its rich history and stunning architecture. Built in the 16th century, the castle offers a glimpse into Japan's feudal past.
- Later, visit to Nishinomaru Garden - Picturesque city park known for its manicured lawns, sculpted topiary & cherry blossoms. A lush garden offers a view of the castle tower across the moat. In spring, some 600 cherry trees in full bloom attract many viewers.
- Have a panoramic view of the Osaka metropolis from the ultramodern Umeda Sky Building which is a landmark of Osaka's Kita Ward. It sprouted up at the end of Japan's economic bubble in 1993. Head to the uniquely designed observation deck for a picture-perfect view of the expansive cityscape.



- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Later visit Osaka Aquarium Kaiyukan - the second aquarium in the world after Okinawa Ocean Expo Aquarium to start keeping whale sharks. Kaiyukan has successfully captivity or breeding 47 species of sharks, 37 species of rays, and 1 species of ghost shark, for a total of 85 species.



- In the evening, enjoy some free time at Dotonbori Shopping Street.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, back to hotel.
- Overnight in Osaka.

Day 11:- Depart Japan / Arrive South Korea.

Visit Lotte Observation Deck. Evening Nanta show in Myeong-dong.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)


- After breakfast at hotel, checkout from hotel and transfer to Osaka International Airport for your flight to Seoul - South Korea.
- Welcome to Seoul - the capital of South Korea. Upon arrival at Incheon International Airport, clear immigration and proceed to arrival hall.
- Seoul is a huge metropolis where modern skyscrapers, high-tech subways, Buddhist temples, palaces and street markets and pop culture meet. Notable attractions include futuristic Dongdaemun Design

Plaza, a convention hall with curving architecture and a rooftop park; Gyeongbokgung Palace, which once had more than 7,000 rooms, Jogyesa Temple and pine trees.

- Proceed for Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch, arrive at hotel and Check-in.
- Some free time to freshen-up before we start our evening tour of Seoul.
- Proceed to Lotte Observation Deck in the evening.
- The Seoul Sky Observatory is located at the top of the Lotte World Tower, the world's fifth tallest building standing 123 stories and 555 meters high. As the tallest building in South Korea, it is the only place where you can take in a gorgeous 360-degree view of Seoul.



- Later in the evening watch world famous Nanta show in Myeong-dong.
- Enjoy A Non-verbal performance integrating Korean traditional Samulnori rhythm. “This is a must see performance” As 750,000 foreign visitors per year come to Korea to enjoy NANTA and Korean culture.
- NANTA also combines rhythms from Korean folk music with modern musical forms to create an experience very unique but familiar to the international audience.
- It combines a storyline with various comic scenes set in a kitchen as its background. Without any verbal scripts, NANTA follows the plots, and it made NANTA well organized.
- To double the fun, all audience can participate in the show and be the bride and groom in a traditional Korean wedding ceremony, compete in piling up dumplings, and interact with the performers.



- After Nanta Show, proceed for dinner.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, transfer back to the hotel.
- Overnight in Seoul.

Day 12:- Full Day Scenic Locations Tour. Gangchon Rail Bike Experience. Visit Nami Island & Petit France – a Cultural Village. (Breakfast & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, get ready to visit some of the most scenic Korean drama locations.
- After around 2 hours drive we reach our first stop at Gangchon Rail Park.



- Experience a railway bike course with a Gimyujeong-themed tunnel that allows you to feel lyrical literature and a beautiful view of the Bukhan river. Gangchon Rail Bike is a great way to enjoy the outdoors and see the Korean countryside. Feel the wind in your hair as you pedal along old railway tracks, taking in the scenic views of the lush countryside and the Bukhangang River.
- We will then proceed to Nami Island.



- Nami Island is a must-visit for anyone traveling to Seoul. There's a child-like quality to the island reminiscent of faeries, elves, and other playful spirits. We relegate them to fantasy as adults but here, they may very well exist. At least that's the feeling you get when you're here. And if that weren't interesting enough, Nami Island is officially known as Naminara Republic, a tiny micronation with its own passport and flag.
- It is artificially decorated small island, famous for drama (Winter Sonata) and beautiful scenery. Spend valuable time at an iconic destination known for its picturesque landscapes and cultural charm.
- You can rent a bicycle and explore at your own pace.



- We then proceed to Petit France - a small village known for French style atmosphere and a drama shooting site (a lover from star). It is inspired by French Village of Alsace.
- Later transfer back to Seoul.
- Arrive Seoul and Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Dinner, transfer back to the hotel.
- Overnight in Seoul.

Day 13:- Full Day City Tour of Seoul. Visit Gyeongbokgung Palace with National Folk Museum. Han River Cruise. Free Time at Myeongdong Shopping Street.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast get ready for Full Day City Tour of Seoul.
- We will pass by Gwanghwamun Plaza - The 555m long and 34m wide Gwanghwamun Square is divided into six sections. At its center stands the statues of King Sejong and Admiral Yi Sunshin.



- The Blue House is a public park that formerly served as the presidential residence and the diplomatic reception halls of South Korea from 1948 to 2022.
- Enjoy Royal Guard Changing Ceremony - such a unique thing to experience. It provides a glimpse into the past when the Sumunjang or royal guard stood watch over the entrance to Gyeongbokgung Palace.
- Visit Jogyesa Temple. This beautiful, colorful temple is the center of Zen Buddhism in Korea. Equally lovely is the courtyard, which is filled with vibrant lanterns and trees more than 500 years old.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Visit Gyeongbokgung Palace - The largest palace is a stunning 14th-century royal residence and the grounds are huge! It was located at the heart of the newly appointed capital of Seoul (then known as Hanyang) and represented the sovereignty of the Joseon Dynasty.



- Visit to National Folk Museum. This museum is a must visit if you are a history nerd, or you're just interested in learning about our past and ancestors. As the repository for over 5,000 years of Korean art,

culture and history, the National Museum of Korea preserves, researches, exhibits and globally promotes the significant and essential cultural heritage of Korea.

- Discover Seoul's attractions on a calm and relaxing ferry cruise on the Han River with mesmerizing views and live music. Cruising on Han River is one of the best ways to enjoy beautiful views of Han River and its many tourist attractions.
- In the evening, head over to vibrant shopping street – Myeongdong. Enjoy great food, interesting stalls and the streets themselves are full of shops with actually nice stuff.
- Particularly, there are lots of beauty and fashion stores here. Most stores will have tax-free shopping so make sure you take your passport to show you're a tourist so you can purchase items tax free.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Dinner, transfer back to the hotel.
- Overnight in Seoul.

Day 14:- Full Day DMZ Tour with Suspension Bridge & 3rd Tunnel.

(Breakfast & Dinner)

- After breakfast, proceed for a Full Day DMZ Tour (Demilitarized Zone).
- DMZ tour is the most popular tour because it is the only chance for you to go very close to the border between two Koreas. Don't you want to go inside the infiltration tunnel made by North Korea? Also, you can see North Korean territory through binoculars at the observatory. For those of you who have no idea about what DMZ is and why Korea is divided into North and South, our experienced Tour Guide will give lots of information about Korea during the tour program.



- Highlights of the DMZ include Imjingak Park, the 3rd Infiltration Tunnel, DMZ Exhibition Hall, Dora Observatory, Dorasan Station, and Unification Village. Return to Imjingak Park, then visit Gloucester Hill Memorial and the Gamaksan Suspension Bridge.
- View the Freedom Bridge and old steam trains as you learn from about the Korean War. Next, drive to the 3rd Tunnel, which the North Korean Army built in the 1970s to infiltrate South Korea.
- After visiting the tunnel, take time to view the exhibits in the DMZ Exhibition Hall, such as displays of old weapons and a film that details the history of Korea.
- Lunch at your own cost.
- Continue to the observatory at Mt Dora to see North Korea through telescopes that are trained on North Korea's propaganda village just over the border.



- Go to Dorasan Station, the final station in South Korea before entering North Korea. As a souvenir, receive a stamp that resembles the immigration desk in the airport (you will not enter North Korea).
- Pass by the Unification Village on the way back to Imjingak Park, and hear from your guide how people wish for the reunification of the two Koreas.
- Head to Gloucester Hill Memorial, an important battlefield during the Korean War before visiting Gloucester Heroes Suspension Bridge. The bridge is stunning and only about 30-40 minutes away from the main DMZ area. You walk a short hike to the bridge and pass through some remnants from a battle held in the area. You can then walk along to a waterfall.
- Later transfer back to Seoul.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Overnight at Seoul.

Day 15:- Depart Seoul / Arrive Home.

(Breakfast)

- Today after breakfast, checkout from the hotel and transfer to Incheon International Airport for our flight back home, collecting all of those wonderful memories and souvenirs gathered from Japan with South Korea Holidays.
