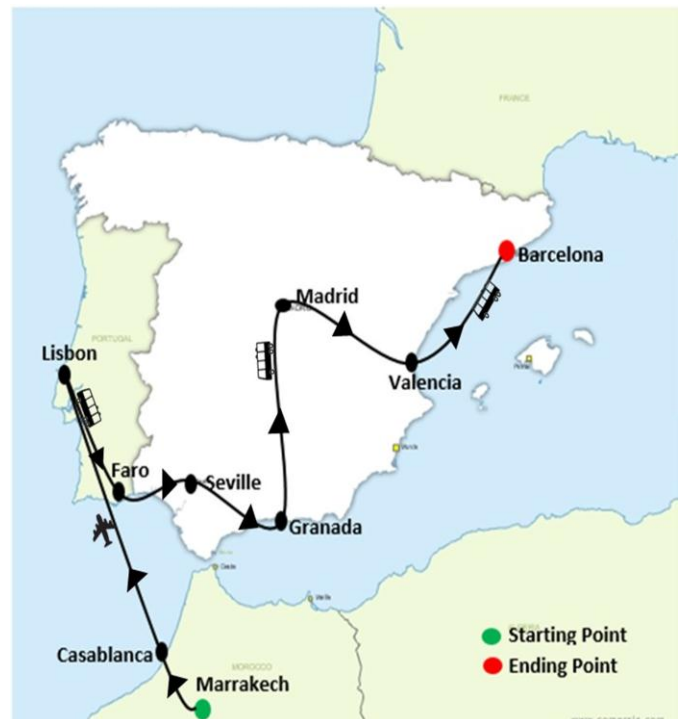

Day 1:- Arrive Casablanca Airport. Transfer to Marrakech. (240 Kms / Approx 03 Hours) Evening Horse Carriage Ride.

(Lunch & Dinner)

- Welcome to Casablanca - the largest city in Morocco!!
- On arrival at Casablanca International Airport, clear immigration and transfer to Marrakech.
- A former imperial city in western Morocco, Marrakech is a major economic center and home to mosques, palaces and gardens.
- Arrive Marrakech and proceed for Lunch
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch, arrive at hotel and Check in.
- In the evening, get ready for Horse Carriage ride.
- Marrakech is one of the few cities in the world to keep the horse carriages as a means of transport. This type of transport has been used for 200 years in the Moroccan city. To see them circulating quietly in the streets, we feel a great desire to borrow one to make a beautiful ride. They allow to explore the ramparts of Marrakech in a horse carriage.



- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Dinner, transfer back to the hotel.
- Overnight in Marrakech.

Day 2:- Full Day City Tour of Marrakech. Evening Free for Shopping at The Souks & Djemaa El Fna. Optional Traditional Coffee Tasting. (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, proceed for full day City Tour of Marrakech.
- First visit is The Menara Garden which has evolved into a tranquil haven that showcases the art of Moroccan garden design through centuries. The garden's centerpiece is a large reflecting pool that dates back to the 12th century, surrounded by lush olive groves and a historic pavilion that offers panoramic views of the surrounding landscape and distant mountains.
- Discover the Koutoubia Mosque in Marrakech, famous for its stunning minaret and rich history. It is a masterpiece of Islamic architecture, renowned for its decorative arches, intricate tile work, and sprawling gardens.



- Visit The Bahia Palace which consists rooms decorated with stunning stuccos, paintings and mosaics palace and a set of gardens. It is 19th century palace of eight hectares in Islamic style, currently a museum.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Lunch, proceed to visit The Mellah - the Jewish quarter & the narrow streets of Mellah. You will discover the spice souk with its various colors and scents, the jewelry souk with an auction and the fabric souk with all kinds of fabrics.
- Visit the souks and handicraft quarters, displaying a variety of items and the famous place Djemaa El Fna with its nonstop entertainment. Djemaa El Fna is a square and market with its snake charmers, traditional musicians, street performers, and exotic food stalls. It's an experience that everyone should have.
- You can also try traditional Morocco coffee at one of this oldest place Bacha Coffee - a café to go back in time. This cafe is an old address, today, you can enjoy your coffee in the same atmosphere, in a decor which has kept all its charm, luxurious. Bacha Coffee offers a unique and memorable experience, according to many travelers, with an atmosphere reminiscent of a Moroccan palace. Guests often appreciate the elegant decor and relaxed setting. (Coffee Tasting Optional at your own cost)



- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Dinner, transfer to the hotel.
- Overnight in Marrakech.

**Day 3:- Checkout. Visit Majorelle Garden, The Berber Museum & Yves Saint Laurent Museum.
Depart Marrakech / Arrive Casablanca. (240 Kms / Approx 03 Hours)**

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, checkout and proceed for Majorelle Garden, The Berber Museum and Yves Saint Laurent.
- Visiting Le Jardin Majorelle is one of the best things to do in Marrakech. This enchanting attraction is iconic nowadays, and is most definitely one of the most visited spots in the Marrakech. The garden hosts more than 15 bird species that are endemic to North Africa.



- The Berber Museum located in the heart of the Majorelle Garden, presents a panorama of the extraordinary creativity of this people, the oldest in North Africa. From the Rif to the Sahara, more than 600 objects collected by Pierre Bergé and Yves Saint Laurent testify to the richness and diversity of a culture still alive. Audiovisual elements are used in the museum to enhance visitors' appreciation of Berber culture.

- Continue the tour to Yves Saint Laurent Museum, the most popular tourist attraction in Morocco welcoming over 850,000 visitors each year. Admire the array of collections on display which feature some of the designer's most precious creations as well as exhibitions documenting saint's life in Marrakech.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Lunch, drive to Casablanca.
- On arrival at Casablanca, proceed for dinner
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Dinner, arrive at hotel and Check in.
- Overnight in Casablanca.

Day 4:- City Tour of Casablanca with Hassan II Mosque. Half Day Tour of Rabat (Capital of Morocco).

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, proceed for City Tour of Casablanca.
- Visit the famous Hassan II Mosque, which accommodates up to 25,000 worshippers. It's a significant landmark tracing Casablanca's history. It's the second-largest mosque in Africa and seventh globally, boasting the world's tallest minaret at 210 meters, topped with a laser directed towards Mecca.



- Visit Royal Palace of Casablanca which is a suitably grand abode for the King of Morocco when he's in town. Located in the Habous Quarter of the city's New Medina, this is the King's principal Casablanca residence and throughout the year hosts royal receptions.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch, transfer to Rabat – Capital of Morocco.
- Explore the capital city of Morocco, a destination unknown to most tourists. The Moroccan capital has a modern outlook, yet is also home to several interesting historic, religious, and cultural sites. Major attractions include the Kasbah of the Oudayas, Mausoleum of Mohammed V, and the Hassan Tower.
- Discover the charm of Rabat from a unique perspective with a scenic boat tour along the city's waterways. Glide through the serene waters of the Bouregreg River and the picturesque Rabat-Sale Marina, taking in stunning views of the city's skyline and waterfront landmarks.
- Later in the evening, transfer to Casablanca.



- Arrive Casablanca and proceed for Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Dinner, transfer to the hotel.
- Overnight in Casablanca.

Day 5:- Depart Casablanca / Arrive Lisbon Airport / Transfer to Hotel. Check-in.
(Breakfast & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, morning free for leisure.
- Later checkout from hotel and transfer to Casablanca Airport to board flight to Lisbon.
- Arrive at Lisbon International Airport, clear immigration and proceed to City.
- Lisbon -the capital of Portugal is famed for its charmingly winding, hilly, cobbled streets lined with pastel toned houses. The city is also modern, bustling and compact, making it easy to get around on foot or bicycle.
- Arrive at Hotel and Check-in.
- Later in the evening, proceed for dinner.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Overnight in Lisbon.

Day 6:- City Tour of Lisbon with Guide. Visit Jeronimos Monastery. River Tagus Cruise.
(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After Breakfast, proceed for City Tour of Lisbon with Guide.
- Our City Tour will cover Photo-Stop at some of the most iconic landmarks of Lisbon.



- Monument of discovery sculpture depicts Henry the Navigator, whose statue heads the line of 33 figures of citizens who were pivotal to Portugal's Age of Discovery. Belem Tower protects Lisbon from incoming raids along the Tagus River.
- You can't miss to visit to Plaza De Comercio. It is a large, harbor-facing plaza in Portugal's capital, Lisbon, and is one of the largest in Portugal, with an area of 30,600 m².
- Proceed for a visit to Jeronimos Monastery.
- The Jerónimos Monastery is one of the most prominent examples of the late Portuguese Gothic Manueline style of architecture. It was classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.



- Immerse yourself by photo Stop at Cristo De Rei. It is one of the most iconic monuments in Lisbon. The statue of Christ stands high above the southern banks of the Tejo Estuary, and depicts Christ with arms raised, blessing the city.
- In the evening enjoy Sightseeing Cruise in Lisbon.
- This River Tagus Guided Sightseeing Cruise will introduce you to Lisbon's highlights from a spectacular vantage point. Avoid the stress of walking through crowds in Lisbon, and instead, admire city landmarks from afar. You'll see Commerce Square, Sao Jorge Castle, Belem Tower, Palace of Ajuda, and much more.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Overnight in Lisbon.

Day 7:- Visit Belem Tower. Vintage Tram Ride.

Depart Lisbon / Arrive Faro (277 kms / Approx 03 Hours).

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, check out from the hotel and proceed for sightseeing of Lisbon.
- Visit Belem Tower.
- It served as a point of embarkation and disembarkation for Portuguese explorers and as a ceremonial gateway to Lisbon. It also marked the beginning of voyages for sailors. The inside of the tower is a real gem that is worth exploring by anyone visiting Lisbon! One major highlight of the Belem Tower is the open terrace at the top.
- Later proceed to ride up and down the hills of Lisbon on board a vintage Tram!
- It's very informative and a great vehicle to get around in Lisbon, passes through many of the most interesting districts of Lisbon. It is taking through old neighborhoods such as Graça, Alfama and Baixa, along many historical highlights, including the cathedral and the castle.



- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch, transfer to Faro.
- Arrive Faro and proceed for Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, arrive at Hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Faro.

Day 8:- Depart Faro / Arrive Albufeira (45 kms / Approx 50 Minutes). Benagil Cave and Dolphin Tour. Depart Albufeira / Arrive Seville (230 kms / Approx 2.5 Hours). (Breakfast & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, we will check out from the hotel and transfer to Albufeira.
- Albufeira is known for its golden sands, red limestone cliffs and breathtaking rock formations. Therefore, it comes as no surprise that one of the main reasons why Albufeira is worth visiting is its selection of amazing beaches. It's a former fishing village that has become a major holiday destination, with sandy beaches and a busy nightlife strip.
- Arrive Albufeira and proceed for Benagil Caves and Dolphin Tour.



- Start your discovery by traveling 18 km along the Algarve coast, from the Albufeira Marina to the Alfanzina Lighthouse. You will be dazzled by several beaches and rock formations and you can visit several sea caves, with special emphasis on the famous Benagil Cave. After the coast, enjoy the sea

breeze as the boats head out to sea in search of dolphins, at which point we invite you to be especially attentive.

- What we want is for the dolphins to see you in the most natural way, respecting them and the observation rules. You will also have the unique opportunity to observe wildlife in its fullest Splendor, from various species of birds to flying fish and sometimes sharks.
- After Caves Tour, back to shore and then proceed to Seville.
- **Lunch on your own.**
- Arrive Seville and proceed for Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, arrive at Hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Seville.

**Day 9:- Full Day for Seville Sightseeing. Horse Carriage Ride. City Tour of Seville with Guide.
Free time at Plaza De La Encarnacion. Flamenco Show with Local Dinner.
(Breakfast, Lunch & Local Dinner)**

- After breakfast at hotel, proceed for full day Seville sightseeing.
- At First, enjoy Horse Carriage Ride. Booking a horse drawn carriage tour around Seville is one of the most romantic things you can do, especially at dusk. It's just magic.
- Enjoy a relaxed and picturesque panoramic ride, passing iconic landmarks like the tobacco factory and the Alfonso XIII Hotel. Explore key attractions, including the Cathedral, Giralda, and Royal Alcazar, in a fun and leisurely manner.
- See the top landmarks of Seville from a horse-drawn carriage during this private tour. Learn about city history from your English-speaking guide while admiring attractions such as Plaza de Espana.
- Get ready for a City Tour of Seville.
- We can't miss photo stop at Seville Cathedral & Alcazar.
- The Seville Cathedral is known for housing the longest nave among all the cathedrals of Spain. The Alcazar in Seville is a very impressive Moorish palace, and also has huge and impressive gardens (which are incredibly peaceful).
- Your visit to Seville will not be completed without visiting at Plaza Espana, Torre De Oro (exterior), Barrio Santa Cruz and view of Guadalquivir river.



- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch, free time at Plaza De La Encarnacion.

- Spend free time in Plaza De La Encarnacion, which used to be a car park but has been transformed by a new piece of architecture the Metropol Parasol. You can walk along a walkway at the top to see the roof tops of old town Seville. There are Great shops nearby and plenty of tapas in la Feria nearby.
- Later in the evening, experience the best of Spain – Flamenco Show.
- Flamenco Show offers authentic performances for an experience which embodies the magic and charm of this ancestral part of Spanish culture.



- The show is approximately one hour and ten minutes and features four to five artists. The performance includes several of the most representative styles of flamenco such as the primitive darkness of la tona and el martinete or the majestic dance of solea. Included are the more festive rumbas and bulerias as well as the beauty of sevillanas. The show is a unique journey through the world of flamenco performed by a collection of talented performers.
- 01 Drink and Local Dinner included with Show.
- Transfer back to the hotel.
- Overnight in Seville.

**Day 10:- Depart Seville / Arrive Granada. (250 kms / Approx 3 Hours).
Visit Alhambra Palace with Generalife Gardens.**

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, check out and transfer to Granada.
- Granada is known for grand examples of medieval architecture dating to the Moorish occupation, especially the Alhambra. This sprawling hilltop fortress complex encompasses royal palaces, serene patios, and reflecting pools from the Nasrid dynasty, fountains and orchards of the Generalife gardens.
- Arrive Granada and proceed for Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch, visit astonishing Alhambra Palace with Generalife Gardens.



- The Alhambra was one of the first Islamic monuments to become the object of modern scientific study and has been the subject of numerous restorations since the 19th century. It is now one of Spain's major tourist attractions and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Designed as a military zone at the beginning, the Alhambra became the royal residence and court of Granada in the mid-13th century after the establishment of the Nasrid Kingdom and the construction of the first palace by the founding king Mohammed ibn Yusuf Ben Nasr, better known as Alhamar.
- We can't miss to visit Generalife Gardens - Best place to sit in the shade and rest. Stunning, relaxing and lush! Beautiful views of Granada. These gardens have been kept immaculate. They are full of fountains and sculpted hedges and beautiful flowers. Spending anything less than a few hours here is a missed opportunity as it indicates an intimate and peaceful atmosphere.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, arrive at the hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Granada.

Day 11:- Depart Granada / Arrive Madrid. (419 kms / Approx 4.5 Hours).

Visit Las Ventas Bull Ring. Evening free for Shopping at Gran Via.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After breakfast at hotel, checkout and transfer to Madrid.
- Madrid is the capital and most populous city of Spain. It is the second-largest city in the European Union (EU).
- Arrive Madrid and proceed for Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch, visit Las Ventas Bull Ring - the largest bullfighting ring in Spain.
- It's a cultural experience like no other. The actual area is fantastic and worth a visit even if you choose not to see a fight.



- Later some free time in Gran Via / City Centre for shopping
- Gran Via is the busiest, most popular street in Madrid. It's 1300m long and more than 100 years old, and lined with some of the most sought-after retail shops in town – a true open-air shopping mall, drawing over 10 million people every year.
- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, arrive at Hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Madrid.

**Day 12:- City Tour of Madrid with Guide. Visit Royal Palace of Madrid.
Evening Walking Tour of Toledo with Guide.**

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- Today after breakfast, proceed for a Full Day Tour of Madrid and Toledo with Guide.
- We will start with City Tour of Madrid.
- This will allow you to get a glimpse of some of Madrid's most outstanding attractions. Our guide will explain all about important places of Madrid and will stop at Templo de Debod and Los Jeronimos.
- Moreover, it's not long until you reach The Royal Palace Madrid, the official residence of the kings of Spain. Marvel at the main staircase by Sabatini, the Throne Room, the Hall of Alabarderos, the Royal Chapel, and more. The palace has 1,450,000 sq ft of floor space and contains 3,418 rooms. It is the largest royal palace in Europe.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post Lunch, transfer to Toledo.
- We will start our Toledo City Tour with Guide and experience photo-stop at Toledo Cathedral, View of Tagus River and Plaza de Zocodover.
- The Plaza de Zocodover is a hub of activity and events in the heart of Toledo. It is surrounded on all sides by a range of impressive buildings and cafés. Relax with a coffee and people-watch in this lively plaza, a short walk west from the Tagus River.



- Proceed to visit to Sword Shops. Toledo has been a traditional sword-making, metal-working center since about the Roman period, and came to the attention of Rome when used by Hannibal in the Punic Wars. It soon became a standard source of weaponry for Roman legions.
- Return back to Madrid and proceed for Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Overnight in Madrid.

**Day 13:- Depart Madrid / Arrive Valencia. (359 kms / Approx 4 Hours).
City Tour of Valencia with Guide.**

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- After Breakfast at your hotel, checkout and proceed to Valencia.
- Valencia is the third largest city in Spain after Madrid and Barcelona.
- The port city of Valencia lies on Spain's southeastern coast, where the Turia River meets the Mediterranean Sea. It's known as City of Arts and Sciences, with futuristic structures including a planetarium, an oceanarium and an interactive museum.
- Arrive Valencia and Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch, proceed for City Tour of Valencia with Guide.
- Your local guide will take you through the pedestrian historic center of Valencia, where you'll find ancient Roman ruins, Saint Mary's Cathedral, several central plazas, including main administrative Plaza Ayuntamiento, and the Lonja Silk Exchange (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), the world's greatest example of gothic architecture and the "Wall Street" of Valencia during medieval times.

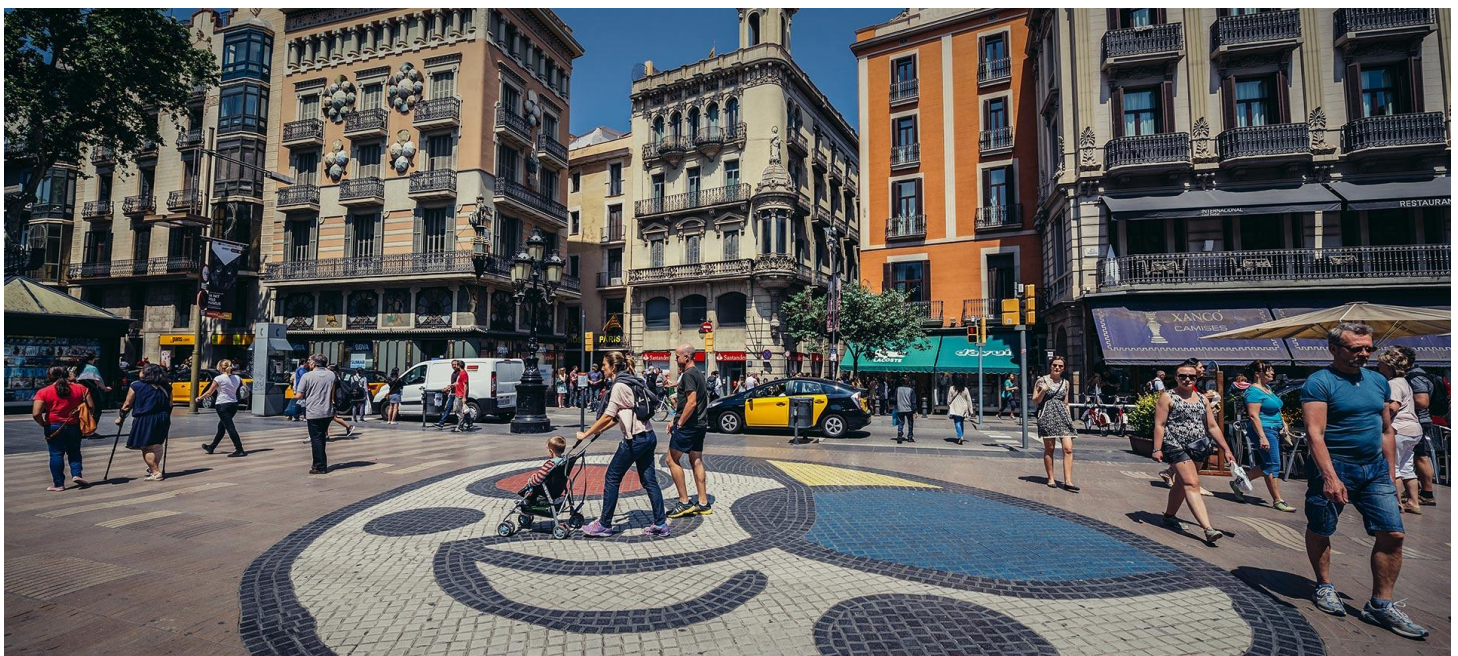


- After city tour, proceed for Dinner at Indian Restaurant.

- Overnight in Valencia.

**Day 14:- Depart Valencia / Arrive Barcelona. (348 kms / Approx 4 Hours).
Visit Gothic Quarter. Free time for shopping at Las Rambla Street.**

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- Today after breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to Barcelona.
- Arrive Barcelona and proceed for Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- Post lunch, visit Gothic Quarter.
- Gothic Quarter - made up of narrow streets and squares that reflect Barcelona's medieval past with the presence of palaces, residences and Gothic churches. The historic center of the city is an architectural jewel. It is a living testimony to the city's rich cultural heritage.
- Later enjoy free time for shopping at Barcelona's famous Las Rambla Street. The melting pot of street artists, musicians, museums, and markets creates a lively and tangible cultural experience.



- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, arrive at Hotel and Check-in.
- Overnight in Barcelona.

**Day 15:- Full Day City Tour of Barcelona with Guide. Visit Sagrada Familia.
Visit Montserrat.**

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

- Today After breakfast, full day to explore the beautiful city of Barcelona.
- We will start our day with City Tour of Barcelona with Guide.
- Explore the incredible history of Barcelona's Gothic Quarter and tour Passeig de Gracia, an elegant boulevard with a wealth of modernist architecture like Gaudí's La Pedrera and Casa Batlló.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant.
- We will continue with our city tour and proceed to visit The Sagrada Familia, which is a Roman-Catholic basilica, is Barcelona's most famous landmark.
- Its official Catalan name is "Temple Expiatori de la Sagrada Família" which means "Temple of Atonement of the Holy Family" in English. Construction work began in 1882 and was later lead by Antoni Gaudí in 1883 who introduced the art style of Modernisme into the design of the basilica.



- The Sagrada Família is projected to be completed on Gaudí's 100th death anniversary in 2026. The construction of the Sagrada Família is exclusively financed by donations and funds from foundations and Catholic groups. The Sagrada Família boasts of unbelievable spatial dimensions, complex embellishments, and magnificent facades & doors- and it should have 18 bell towers by the completion of the construction. On 7 November 7th 2010, Pope Benedikt XVI consecrated the Sagrada Família and elevated it to the status "basilica."
- We will then proceed to Montserrat. It takes around an hour to arrive Montserrat.
- Admire the Massif of Montserrat, a spectacular multi-peaked rocky range packed with unique needle-shape formations. Learn about the cornerstone of the Catalan culture, history, nature and spirituality. Once you get there, enjoy an exclusive guided tour in the Monastery basilica—home to the revered 'Black Madonna' statue—and the atrium, cloister and main square.



- Dinner at Indian Restaurant.
- Post dinner, back to hotel.
- Overnight in Barcelona.

Day 16:- Depart Barcelona / Arrive Home.

(Breakfast)

- Today after breakfast, checkout from hotel and transfer to Airport for our flight back home, collecting all of those wonderful memories and souvenirs gathered from your Spain & Portugal Holidays.
